

Overview





History

- ▶ 2000: Start of VPL on policy level in BE-Flanders
 - → Flemish Government asks advice on VPL
 - → 2002: Research report, pilot projects,
 - → call for **an integrated approach** across the policy domains
- however
 - → Decrees on Socio-cultural organizations, Youth, Sports: VPL
 - → 2004: Decree Work: certificate of work experience
 - → 2004: Decree Higher education: VPL part of flexibilization
 - → 2007: Decree Adult education VPL -> exemptions
- ▶ Result: **fragmentation** of policies on VPL



Current situation

Fragmentation between policy domains

- ▶ Low numbers of validation uptake
- Limited societal impact of validation

Call for an integrated approach



2000 Separate policies 2019

Parliamentary Act of 3
April '19 on 'An
integrated policy' adopted by unanimity




Explanation?

- → VPL stayed on the political agenda national, European
- → Acceptance of competency approach
- → Availability of a common reference framework (standard)





Process of coming to legislation





Content of Parliamentary Act on VPL

- Definition
 - → Identification / documentation assessment / certification
- ▶ Assessment of competences based on common framework
 - → NQF Flemish Qualification Framework
 - → Recognized validation bodies (assessment centres)
 - → Assessment instruments conform validation standards
- Certification
 - → Full professional qualification (or part), proof of competences
- Quality assurance
 - → Recognition Quality control



Opportunities

- ▶ One decree for all policy domains > comprehensive
 - → Education, work, third sector (culture, youth, sports)
- One definition for VPL
- ▶ One reference framework: FQF
- ▶ Regulations about quality assurance
 - → Standards for validation
 - → Common quality framework (inside/outside education)
 - → Quality control body every 6 years
- Procedures and structures
- ▶ Information and guidance



Challenges

- Implementation has yet to start!
- ▶ Limited to professional (occupational) qualifications
 - → educational qualifications?
- ▶ In education: focus on adult education
 - → Elaboration to in HE
- ▶ Granting full qualifications versus granting exemptions?
- Quality control bodies differ according to policy domain
- ▶ Each policy domain is responsible for
 - → Recognition
 - → financing own validation bodies
- ▶ VPL: an individual right?
