# Create a digital portfolio suitable for transdisciplinary VPL

- Low-level (sentence, word) comments by reviewer / expert
- Low-level analysis by applicant
- Multi-level (text, achievement, portfolio) analysis views
- Multi-level documents management
- High-level (group) applicant tracking and notifications
- Specialized and flexible tool for varied specific use cases (curricula, skills frameworks, applicant-defined soft-skills, ...)
- Modern architecture (SQL⇔JS dynamic analysis, localization)
- Ergonomic: easy and fun to use

#### **Details**


### Empowering the applicant by

- Providing tools to focus on her or his own singular experience
  Singular experience is the starting point
- Providing a framework to guide the applicant through progressive steps of recognizing her / his singular experience (RPL)

## Through a continuous back and forth reflexive motion

### Such as ...

- Identify key lived moments
- **B** Identify key context elements
- F Describe lived actions and thoughts
- B Analyze (tag) key moments
- F Insert relevant artefacts (medias)
- **B** Continuous multi-level feedback
